### School Improvement Plan

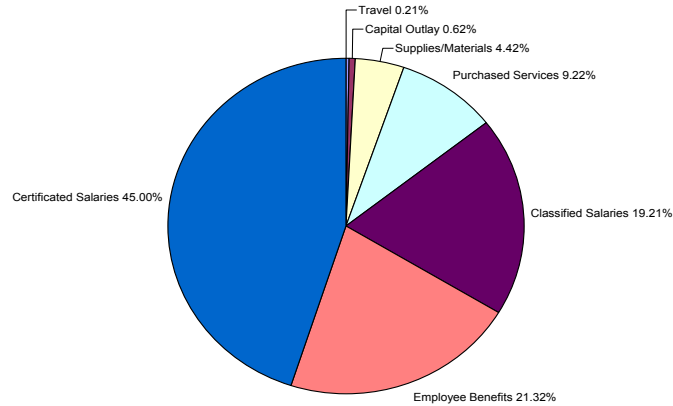
Our school improvement plan is focused on teacher development and building a database for charting student achievement. Our goals include:

3. In association with other Parent Partner Programs, develop additional support for enhanced program requirements which have resulted from new state regulations.

### Invitation to Parents

Continual parental involvement is required of all families. Parents teach core academic subjects at home and supervise their children's daily off-site learning activities. Parents and staff work together to develop a year-long learning plan for each student. Progress on this plan is evaluated monthly by parents and staff. Parents of children age 12 and under are required to remain on-site while their children attend on-site classes.
