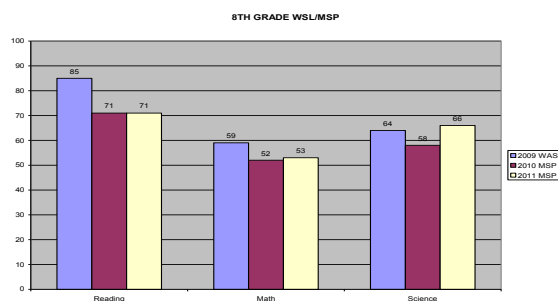
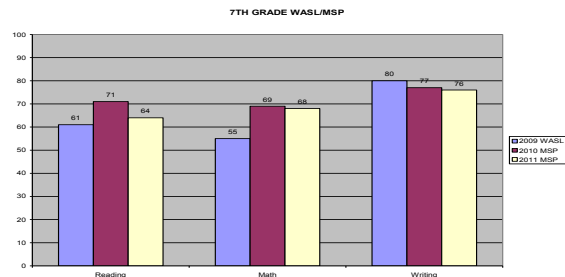
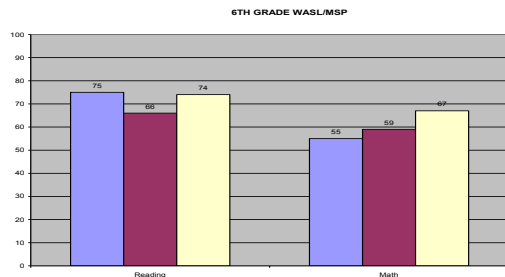

School Improvement Plan

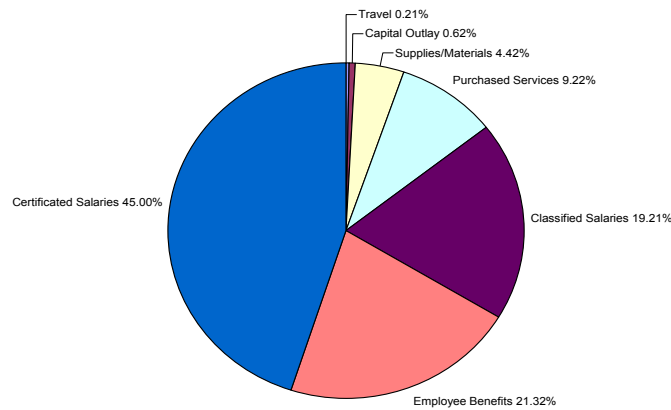
1. Our Building Goal is to raise math achievement to 60 percent or higher and reduce level 1's and 2's by 12 percent on the MSP.
