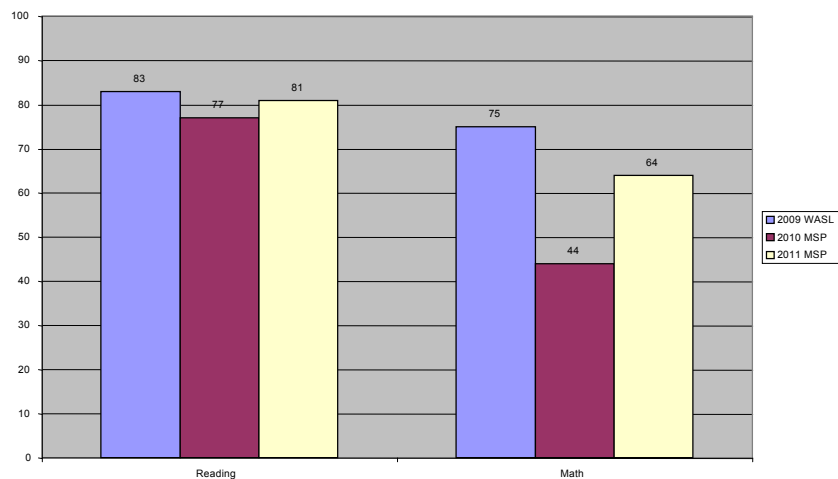

3RD GRADE BLAINE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL WASL/MSP



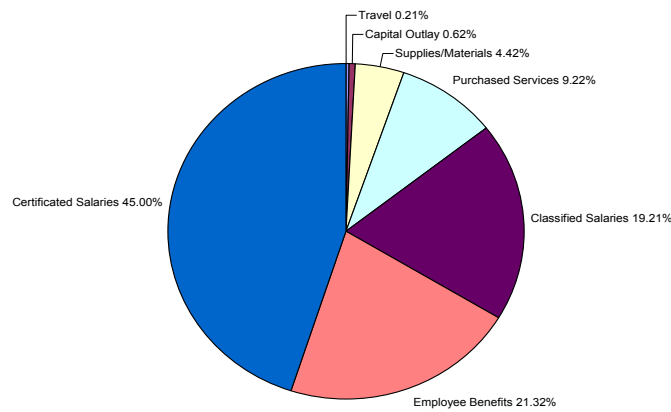
### School Improvement Plan
